Official Response to Urgent Message Circulated to North Claremont Neighborhood Residents on or about March 22, 2020:

It has come to Three Valleys Municipal Water District's (TVMWD) attention that a concerning letter has been distributed to homes in the north Claremont area regarding the operations of the TVMWD Miramar Treatment Plant. The letter describes critical infrastructure and operational plans including attempts by someone from the public to disclose vulnerabilities that should not be publicly disclosed due to security reasons.

The TVMWD has safely operated in Claremont since 1985 without incident and continues to embrace and implement new technology and make operational advancements. TVMWD staff work closely with the Claremont Police Department, LA County Fire, Department of Homeland Security and the FBI to ensure the facility is safe and provides equally safe drinking water, that meets or exceeds all State and Federal requirements. Furthermore, TVMWD has received approval for remote operations during certain segments of the day from the State of California, Department of Public Health, Division of Drinking Water (DDW), the regulatory agency that issues our drinking water permit. TVMWD has built in multiple safeguards in its operation to ensure the safety of the public.

TVMWD holds public Board meetings on the first and third Wednesday of each month. All meetings have a public comment section reserved on the agenda that allows members of the public to address the board on items not specifically mentioned on the agenda. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, all public board meetings for TVMWD can be accessed remotely and public comment provided remotely.
